The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, December 15, 2011, with four members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including: Kaycie Bowen broke her own team record in the 100 backstroke event and the “Aspire to Inspire” Empowerment Program was held this Monday at the F-S Community Park Ag Bldg. Several women from the community spoke at the program. Visit South Central Bank’s Facebook page and vote for Jerrell Wickware as “Player of the Month” to help FSHS’s Athletic Dept. win a \$500 donation. The LES Robotics Team won first place project award at the Regional level and will advance to the State First Lego League Challenge at WKU on January 14<sup>th</sup>. Students from FSHS, LES and SES will advance to STLP State competition in March 2012 at Rupp Arena in Lexington. The FFA Jr. Parliamentary Procedure Team, and Luke Mills, earned first place at Regional FFA competition and will compete at the State FFA competition in June. The F-S Wildcats Football team became Class 4A State Runner Up. “Operation Preparation” will provide 8<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> graders mentoring for post secondary planning. It’s a great way for parents/community to get involved. Sign up will be in January and mentoring March 12th-16th. Mr. Flynn also discussed what the state shared as the “big ideas” for improvement at the high school. Their final reports are due back within thirty days and the public will be notified. We are already taking steps to improve in all measures.
2. Chairperson David Webster called the meeting to order and the agenda was approved.
