The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, February 18, 2010, with all three members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including MLK contest winners: FSHS students Kari Kinder and Robert Clark won \$100 each in art and essay, Naomi Sandahl won \$50 and Jade Miller won \$25. At Lincoln Elementary's poster contest, Kourtne Turner won \$50, Desirae Grace won \$25 and Kathy Juarez \$10. 3rd grade coloring contest winners were Katlyn Barnes, Rebecca Barnett and Olivia Lawson. 2nd grade winners were Trey Shanklin, Kaleb Rogers and Lilly Spears. 1st grade winners were Vidhi Parekh, Ethan Smith and Hanna Herston. Kindergarten winners were Julianna Whitney, Faith Adams and Ben Banton. Pre-K winners were Zyshonne Anderson, Meghan Roberts and Kira Coleman. The FSHS Cheerleaders placed 1st in District and 2nd in Region 4 KAPOS competition. Seven F-S cheerleaders were recognized for Academic Achievement: Lindsey Traughber, Kelsey Patterson, Caitlin Laster, Emmy Martin, Destini England, Alyssa Bush and Brianna Stephens. Seniors Kelsey Patterson and Lindsey Traughber were awarded Region 4 KAPOS Scholarships. Senior, Sabrina Ferreri was crowned the 2010 FSHS Basketball Homecoming Queen. Simpson County Schools was recently named as one of the *Best Places to Work in Kentucky 2010!* FSHS juniors will take the ACT college entrance exam on March 9th.
