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FEBRUARY 19, 2015

The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, February 19, 2015, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Supt. Flynn made welcome announcements including –
 - The Local Planning Committee will meet Monday, February 23rd beginning with a Public Forum at 5:30 at the Central Office
 - The first FES Little Cats program has been rescheduled for Thursday, February 26th
 - FSHS' ACT Blitz Nights are scheduled for February 23rd, 24th and 26th from 5-7:30 p.m.
 - Congratulations to the FSMS Speech team on their third place finish at Regionals on Feb. 14th at Warren East HS. Every member of the FSMS team qualified to advance State competition, which will be held at the University of Kentucky March 27th-28th. Chaze Vinci captured 1st place in broadcast announcing, and Jenna Robertson won 2nd. Second place ribbons also went to Hailey Brandon in impromptu speaking, Zaid Hendi in extemporaneous speaking, and Seyan Perry and Martina Jones in improvisational duo. Katlyn Barnes, Mikayla Gregory, Makayla Huff, Katie Hollingsworth, Katie Hunter, Noah Lyle, Collin Preston, Aaron Slack, Emily Schmieder, Laura Tomas, and Colt Toth round out the state-bound team. Michelle Harris coaches the FSMS Speech Team, and Laura Benton Elliott is her assistant.
