BULLETIN-BOARD

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The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, January 27, 2011, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including proposed 2010-2011 calendar revisions due to snow days, 14 FSHS students who took time out of their winter break to join forces with the local VFW to deliver Christmas cards and treats to patients at the Veterans Hospital, LES Leadership students grant acceptance for a historical marker, success of the Swimcats at their "home" meet they hosted in Gallatin, Miles Ferrell earning Total Fitness Connection Athlete of the Week, and Simpson County Schools earning Best Place to Work in KY 2nd year in a row! He invited all parents to the next DPAC meeting Monday, February 7th @ 6pm in the FSHS Cafeteria. In recognition of School Board Appreciation Month, Mr. Flynn expressed his gratitude for the work that the board members do throughout the year and presented them with a small token of appreciation.
2. Chairperson David Webster called the meeting to order. The agenda was approved.
3. Jacquelyn Scates, Simpson County Junior Miss shared her experiences at the recent Kentucky Junior Miss, where she won an Academic scholarship. Mr. Flynn presented Ms. Scates with a certificate of excellence for her accomplishments.
