The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, July 15, 2010, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including our new staff member Amanda Deweese (Chief Financial Officer for Simpson County Schools) and veteran staff Simpson County Educator Denise Reetzke (now leading Gifted and Literacy Education). The F-S Learning Opportunity Center was named a “Best Practice Site” in Kentucky. The Simpson County Truancy Diversion team was one of the 10 groups recognized at Law Day 2010 during a ceremony at the Capitol Building in Frankfort. Recent FSHS graduate Lindsey Traughber won 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the nation (in the Extemporaneous Poster event) at the annual HOSA Leadership Conference held in Orlando, FL. District wide school registration will be held from 9-6 on Tuesday, July 20<sup>th</sup> and from 11-6 on Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup>. All schools will also be holding Open House events (information is on the school website).
2. Chairperson David Webster called the meeting to order. Mr. Flynn requested that Pay Application #1 for the FSHS Gym Project be a separate agenda item from Bills and Payments (as recommended by Tim Geegan, Alliance) for KDE purposes. The agenda was approved.
3. Bill Porter, RTC Director gave an update of the Regional Training program. He also introduced Cynthia McCombs, new RTC Early Childhood Specialist. As representative of the Simpson County Retired Teachers’ Association, Mr. Porter presented a \$200 donation to each of the school libraries, including LOPC.
3. During Visitor Comments, Mr. Tim Geegan (Alliance Corporation) gave a construction update on the FSHS gym. They are presently completing the footings, underground plumbing is in the works and walls have started going up. Everything is on schedule and ready for school to start.
4. Superintendent and Staff Reports included: On Track program report, annual dropout report, monthly staff attendance report, ODT student trips, ODT administrative travel, Food Service financial report, 2010-2011 Student Handbooks, monthly investment report and fuel bid (none for June).
5. The following personnel report was submitted. Employment was reported for 3 certified guest teachers, 1 elementary teacher at LES, 1 entry level teacher at FES, 3 certified teachers at FSHS, 1 Itinerant Speech/Language Pathologist, 1 Director of Finance, 1 RTC Early Childhood Specialist, 2 certified teachers at FSMS, 1 Lead Custodian, 1 Custodian and 1 (4-hour) Itinerant Custodian, 5 transfers, and 1 retirement were reported.
6. The following consent items were approved:
  - Approve monthly financial report
  - Approve minutes of previous meetings
  - Approve bills, salaries and regular accounts
  - Approve 2010-11 Employee Handbook
  - Approve fundraising activities for SES
