

THE SIMPSON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

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The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, July 17, 2008, with all members present. Superintendent Jim Flynn made some announcements and introduced new principals—Shelina Smith (FSMS) and Adam Hatcher (LOPC). The following business was transacted.

1. The agenda was approved.
2. Visitors recognized included a special needs student's grandparent who discussed the diploma the student will receive upon graduation. The architect gave an update on construction projects.
3. Superintendent and staff reports included review of handbooks from Lincoln Elementary and Franklin-Simpson High School, and out-of-district administrative travel.
4. The following personnel report was submitted. Employment was reported for seven certified, one classified, and two certified substitute employees. Ten transfers and one resignation were included in the report. One employee returned from FMLA.
5. The following consent items were approved:
 - Minutes of the previous meetings
 - Payment of bills, salaries and regular accounts
 - Revision to job description for RTC Early Childhood Specialist (1.17)
 - Projected fund-raising activities for Simpson Elementary for 2008-209
6. The monthly financial report was approved.
7. Approval was given to the continuing contract for students attending the Gatton Academy of Mathematics and Science in Kentucky.
8. Food Service bids were awarded.
9. School fee schedules were approved.
10. The Board met for a work session to discuss goals for the superintendent.
