The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, March 17, 2011, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including congratulations to Mr. Ragland and the Wildcat band. The band received a distinguished rating in 16 events at the KMEA Solo & Ensemble festival. Shannon Janitch was also recommended to attend the KMEA state solo festival in May. Chastity Gooch was named Player of the Year for Region 4 by the KABC. FSHS students Khalis McCullon, Briana Smith and Trey Black took 1st place in their region in the Fall Stock Market game. The Simpson-Lincoln Academic team took 1st place in the KAAC District competition. Tayshaun Hassell is the statewide champion in his age division of the KCNPNM Poster Contest. FSHS FFA's Sr. Parliamentary team took home 1st place in their section at the Spencer Co. Invitational. All schools in the Simpson County completed the accreditation process. Mr. Flynn thanked parents who attended the DPAC meeting Monday night, for their input. FSHS presents "*Once on this Island*" at the Goodnight Auditorium March 25th-27th. Chairman David Webster was elected to the Kentucky School Board Association board of directors. Simpson County Schools is one of 388 school districts in the nation being honored by the College Board with a place on its AP[®] Achievement List (one of only 5 in Kentucky).
2. Chairperson David Webster called the meeting to order. The agenda was approved.
3. Mr. Flynn presented the board with the ASAP certificate. KSBA recognizes school districts who have meet 10 standards, throughout the year, which promote student learning.
4. Two students from Franklin Elementary demonstrated Earobics, an interactive software that provides instruction in early literacy skills.
5. Stacy Raymer, FES Principal and Craig Delk, FSMS Interim Principal, gave updates on progress of their school SMART goals.
6. Jeff Wells, Alliance Corporation, announced that the project is making good progress. Wood flooring and bleachers will be installed at the FSHS gym in the next few weeks. Ceiling grid samples will be provided to the board next week.
7. Superintendent and Staff Reports included: monthly ADA and dropout reports, monthly staff attendance, ODT student trips, Spring sports schedule, ODT administrative travel, construction reconciliation, monthly vendor report, monthly reconciliation, daycare financial report, food service report, monthly investment report, project graduation donations, review G/T programs, literacy report, WKU Confucius Institute, review CDIP, review achievement gap targets, and postsecondary plans for the class of 2011.
