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OCTOBER 20, 2011

The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, October 20, 2011, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. Flynn made welcome announcements including school employees' Open Enrollment through October 28th, School Bus Safety Week, FSHS Senior Nick Fuqua tied for 5th @ the boys' state golf tournament and 8th grader Mary Joiner also qualified for state and had a good showing. The Lady Wildcat Softball boosters will hold a chili supper before the football game Friday, October 21st. F-S will face Allen Co.-Scottsville. Kentucky Safe Schools week is October 16-22 and the focus this year is on cyber safety. The FSHS Wildcats Marching Band finished with best percussion, best color guard and 1st place in AAA at the Grayson County contest. They will be competing in Region quarterfinals this Saturday night at Hart County HS. The band's annual fruit sale is underway until November 10th. Daylight Saving Time ends on Sunday, November 6th and there is a Learning Community Day on Tuesday, November 8th (no students).
2. Chairperson David Webster called the meeting to order and the agenda was approved.
3. FSMS Principal Daryl Woods and CIA Josh Tucker spoke on where the MS's headed – with a focus on rigor and student engagement. The school's Social Studies scores are #11 in the state! Ms. Robinson's 8th grade enrichment class presented a video made on their iPad.
