The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, October 22, 2009, with all members present. The following business was transacted.

1. Mr. James Flynn, Superintendent made welcome announcements-Congratulations went to Junior Miss winners: Mariah Rowland, Lee Fowler, Kari Kinder, Kelsey Patterson, Lindsey Traugher, Morgan Cook and Jessi Eaton; FSEEF Teacher of the Month: Cindy Phillips of FSMS; FSHS Homecoming Queen: Meghan Meador, Wildcats Soccer team's 9<sup>th</sup> District tournament win; All District Soccer players: Hunter Flynn, Kristian Clark and Ian Greer; All District Lady Cats soccer players: Carissa Estes, Courtney Ladd and JoAnn Scott; BG Daily News "Athlete of the Week": Jerrell Wickware.
