BULLETIN-BOARD

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AUGUST 21, 2014

The Simpson County Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, August 21, 2014, with all members present. Brigitte Crawford arrived at 6:20 p.m. The following business was transacted.

1. Supt. Flynn made welcome announcements including –
 - Thank you to all staff working, students and parents for a smooth start to the school year.
 - The FSHS FFA Agronomy team placed 2nd at the Kentucky State Fair.
 - FSHS student, Karen Melendez, was recognized as a national winner at HOSA Nationals for her newsletter “HOSA Happenings”.

 - A Chamber of Commerce “Business after Hours” will be held in September to welcome the Chinese teachers to our district. Supt. Flynn thanked the sponsors of the Chinese teacher program in Simpson County, which serves grades 1-12.
